- Excessive noise from residence (32-135)	\$ 124.00
- Sale/Furn malt bev. to underage (4-6)	\$ 313.00
- Sale/Furn liquor to underage (4-6)	\$ 313.00
- Serving an intoxicated person (4-7)	\$ 313.00
- Underage drinking (4-9)- 1 st Offense	\$ 250.00
- 2 nd Offense	\$ 407.50
- 3 rd Offense	\$ 565.00
- 4 th Offense	\$ 691.00
- 5 th Offense	\$ 817.00
- Unregistered Kegs ((4-111)	\$ 1,321.00
- Public Consumption (32-106)	\$ 124.00
- Possession of street sign (44-4)	\$ 187.00
